## 2022

### CENTRAL VALLEY AOR

Program that offered fifty \$1,000 grants in closing costs to first time homebuyers who are teachers or first responders when they purchase a home in the Stanislaus and San Joaquin County Regions.



### LODI AOR

Program that awarded \$1,000 after close of escrow to individuals who qualify as a Hero. Aimed at our Military, Veterans, Police, Firefighters, Doctors, Nurses, EMT-EMS, and Educators.

### CONEJO SIMI MOORPARK AOR

Program distributed a \$2,500 grants to 40 qualified First-Time Homebuyers on a first-come-first-served basis (after closing escrow on a purchase for a qualified property).



## 2021

### CALIFORNIA DESERT AOR

Program promoted homeownership for first-time buyers by Closing Cost or Downpayment program which offered \$2000 grant per applicant.



### THE INLAND GATEWAY

Program that offered in increments of up to \$400 (or actual cost per the Paid Receipt) per closed purchase by a first-time homebuyer who paid for a Professional Home Inspection of the Subject Property during their escrow.



### TUOLUMNE COUNTY AOR

Program provided up to 120 homeowners a grant to help cover the Insurance Premium for their new, primary residence in Tuolumne County.

### SANTA CLARA AOR

First-time homebuyer down payment assistance program that allowed low-income individuals eligible for the Santa Clara County Empower Homebuyer Program to receive up to \$10,000 of down payment grant assistance

### PARADISE COUNTY AOR

Project that worked with a public service program to conduct a needs assessment and implement a vision for housing and commercial redevelopment in Paradise to assist with the recovery from the 2018 wildfire known as the Camp Fire.

### CONTRA COSTA AOR

Program that provided a no-interest loan of up to \$15,000.00 for closing costs, down payment assistance, or other financial needs to ensure the close of escrow on a buyer's first home.

### LODI AOR

Program promoted homeownership for first-time buyers by providing them with \$500 grant after closing escrow.

### NEVADA COUNTY AOR

Program offered \$1,000 grants for a fire insurance premium to first-time homebuyers.



### PACIFIC SOUTHWEST AOR

Closing cost assistance that offered \$1,500 to help veterans & active duty personnel.

### SOUTHLAND REGIONAL AOR

Down payment assistance to first-time homebuyers, \$2,000 per family.

### BAKERSFIELD AOR

Offered qualified first-time homebuyers up to \$2,000 each to help with closing costs following the close of escrow.



## 2020

### BRIDGE AOR

Closing Cost Assistance grant provided qualified public employee homebuyers an additional source of funding for their closing costs.

### NORTHERN SOLANO COUNTY AOR

A Hometown Hero's grant program which provided \$1,000 grants to active duty military, teachers, health care workers, fire and police personnel who are first-time buyers.
